- Maintains web sites and makes modifications and enhancements.
- Creates image links and ensures that the links are working properly.
- Develops applications to specifications for use in web page deployment.
- Programs HTML and uploads the pages to the web site.
- Tests and trouble shoots problems and repairs the web site. Performs additional duties as required
